Certain public lands should be made available for agricultural and urban uses. The policies in this policy plan give direction on which lands should be disposed of by the federal government. Disposal must be in coordination with local government officials. There should be extensive public involvement and concurrence in the identification of lands for disposal. As specific parcels of public lands are proposed for disposal, site specific information must be made available to the public and environmental assessments developed. Table 2 describes the type of lands that should be released to the private sector.
